1. **Age:** 16–20 years old.
 2. **Team Affiliation:**
 - o Current Calgary Canucks players actively participating in the program, **or**
 - o Calgary and area based male or female hockey players affiliated with recognized clubs or leagues.
 3. **Academic Excellence:** Applicants must provide evidence of high school academic performance (report cards, transcripts, or official school records).
 4. **Leadership and Community Engagement:** Demonstrated involvement in volunteer work, team leadership, or community initiatives.
 5. **Hockey Skills:** Applicants must exhibit high-level technical ability, commitment to training, and positive sportsmanship.
